## **Certification Procedure Flow**

### Prepare **Documents**



#### Download the required documents from the JLIA Sustainable Certification website.

Complete them following the "Application Guide" and submit them along with the necessary attachments.

- Factory layout map (including site map) and manufacturing equipment layout
- Copy of documents showing the source of raw materials
- Manufacturing process flowchart
- Copy of documents certifying proper wastewater treatment Copy of documents certifying proper waste disposal
- Copy of documents for quality inspection of leather/leather products
- Raw material acceptance inspection records Complaint handling records
- Copy of document certifying that the main leather has tested for chemicals as specified in the Japan Eco Leather Gold certification.

#### Assessment

**Document** Review by the Secretariat



The Japan Leather and **Leather Goods Industries** Association (JLIA) receives and reviews the submitted application documents.

**On-site Audit of Applicant** Companies



In addition to document review, on-site inspections are conducted at the applicant's facilities.

**Review Meeting by** the Third-Party Committee



A third-party committee conducts the final assessment.
